We have started a unit of STEM work focusing on biodiversity and climate change. This week we were learning about the polar bear-we used LEGO to create some solutions to climate change.

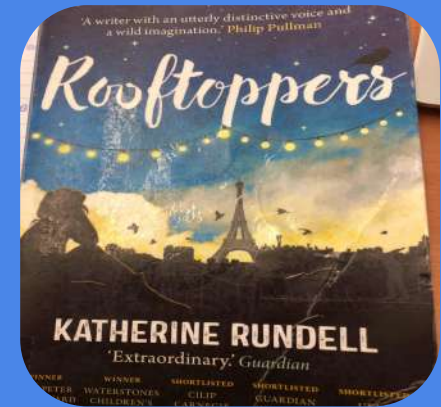


5th Class
