- (\mathbf{P}) Drop off takes place between 8.50am to 9.20am.
- Please follow the 'Drop and Go' system
- Only collect at the appointed time for your children.
- At h Pupils are encouraged to walk or cycle to school.
 - To pick up a child during school hours, please phone first.
- There will be no access to the classroom for parents or 0 visitors, bar exceptional circumstances.
- ۴Ð All staff will complete COVID induction training.
 - Pupils should come prepared for all types of weather.
- Ø As per current guidelines, all staff will wear a mask when physical distancing is not possible.
- Pupils and staff will wash their hands regularly, using proper technique.



Everyone will use the hand sanitiser provided on entry and exit

- The class will be cleaned daily. The school has purchased a D. mobile sanitiser to sanitise the classrooms each evening. Toys will be disinfected weekly.
- Pupils must be kept home with high temperature, cough, (2) breathing difficulties or loss of taste or smell. Pupils should also be kept home if generally unwell.
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Pupils should stay home for 14 days after returning from a country not on the green list.

If showing symptoms, pupils will be isolated and parents called. Parents will contact the GP for further advice.



- Each class is a bubble and pods will be formed within each class.
- Physical distancing is not a requirement for Juniors to 2nd <u>೧...</u>೧ class. Pupils in 3rd-6th will physically distance themselves in their pods in their classrooms.
- Pupils should bring a full pencil case of stationery on the first l day. This will remain in school.
