Dear Parent/Guardian,

Since September 2023, schoolbooks, workbooks and copy books for children in recognised primary schools have been provided to every child free by their school. There is no charge to parents/guardians for this, as schools receive funding from the Government to cover these costs. **This funding has been reduced this year from €96 per pupil in 2023/2024 to €80 per pupil for 2024/2025.**

Your child will receive a mixture of new books and workbooks along with books from our school store of classroom books. These books will be distributed to your child when we return to school on 28th August. It is important that books are kept in good condition so they can be reused. Please make sure your child keeps the school books safe and takes care of them, so they can be used again by another child in the future.

In the table below, your child's class teacher has outlined the stationery required for the school year ahead. **These items do need to be purchased by parents.** You will note that your child's class teacher may have requested copybook covers. We strongly recommend that parents purchase these as they will help maintain copies throughout the year.
