Dear Parent/Guardian,

Since September 2023, schoolbooks, workbooks and copy books for children in recognised primary schools have been provided to every child free by their school. There is no charge to parents/guardians for this, as schools receive funding from the Government to cover these costs.

Your child will receive a mixture of new books and workbooks along with books from our school store of classroom books. These books will be distributed to your child when we return to school on 27th August. It is important that books are kept in good condition so they can be reused. Please make sure your child keeps the school books safe and takes care of them, so they can be used again by another child in the future.

In the table below, your child's class teacher has outlined the stationery required for the school year ahead. **These items do need to be purchased by parents.** You will note that your child's class teacher may have requested copybook covers. We strongly recommend that parents purchase these as they will help maintain copies throughout the year.

School Bag/Lunch box/Bottle	Your child requires a standard-sized school bag that can comfortably fit their A4 folder but must not have wheels as these do not fit under their desk. Your child will need the reusable hot lunch box provided or one of similar size and a strong, reusable bottle that they can open and close independently.	As we are a Green School, we would appreciate it if your child reuses their lunch box & bottle so as to reduce waste.
Folders	1 x extra durable mesh storage wallet (A4 size) 1 x A4 ring folder (standard) for filing. 10 x A4 clear plastic pockets for filing worksheets.
